

## Filling the Tray: Features of Behavior Support

Each tier of the multi-tiered system of behavior support includes common features. These features can be conceptualized as parts of a cafeteria tray. If any compartment is empty or too sparse, it will weaken the strength of the entire system. Conversely, if the contents of a compartment are overfull, it will result in initiative overload or confusion. Each district and campus should clearly define the core features of their “tray” for behavior support and connect all future initiatives to these features.
