## **Stakeholder Review of Expectations**

Once drafted, Ground Work teams should solicit feedback from stakeholders regarding the campus matrix of behavior expectations. Stakeholders include other campus staff, students, and families/community members. This feedback may be solicited through written communication or focus groups. Below are example questions to prompt feedback from stakeholders:

Families & Community	<ol> <li>What does "safe" mean to you?</li> <li>What does "respect" mean to you?</li> <li>What does "responsible" mean to you?</li> <li>What are some of the behavior expectations you enforce or value with your child at home?</li> <li>Review the campus matrix, are there expectations that go against any values or behaviors you use at home?</li> <li>What expectations would you like to see added or represented?</li> <li>What expectations need to be rethought or revised?</li> </ol>
